

BY-LAW NO. 33-04
OF THE
CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to prohibit and regulate the used lands or structures for the storing of inoperable motor vehicles and to repeal By-law 161-97.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, S.131 provides that a municipality may pass by-laws prohibiting and regulating the use of any land for the storage of used motor vehicles for the purpose of wrecking or dismantling them or salvaging parts from them for sale or other disposition;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge deems it necessary to prohibit and regulate the storage of used motor vehicles within the limits of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

DEFINITIONS

1. That in this by-law:
 - a) "Motor Vehicles" shall include automobile, motorcycle, and any other vehicle propelled or driven otherwise than by muscular power; but does not include the cars of electric stream railways, or other motor vehicles running only upon rails, or a motorized snow vehicle, traction engine, farm tractor, self-propelled implement of husbandry or road building machine within the meaning of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter H8.
 - b) "Inoperative Motor Vehicle" means a motor vehicle not licensed for the current year or one which if in operation on a public highway would fail to meet the requirements of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O., 1990 as amended.
2. No land within the limits of the City of Cambridge, except land zoned for that purpose, shall be used for the storage of inoperative or partly dismantled motor vehicles or parts of motor vehicles for more than forty-eight (48) hours unless said vehicle or parts thereof are stores in an enclosed building.

OFFENCE

3. THAT a person who contravenes any provisions of this by-law is upon conviction, guilty of an offence and is liable to any penalty as provided for by The Provincial Offences Act.

SHORT TITLE

4. This by-law may be cited as the "Inoperative Vehicle By-law".
5. THAT City of Cambridge By-law No. 161-97 is hereby repealed.
