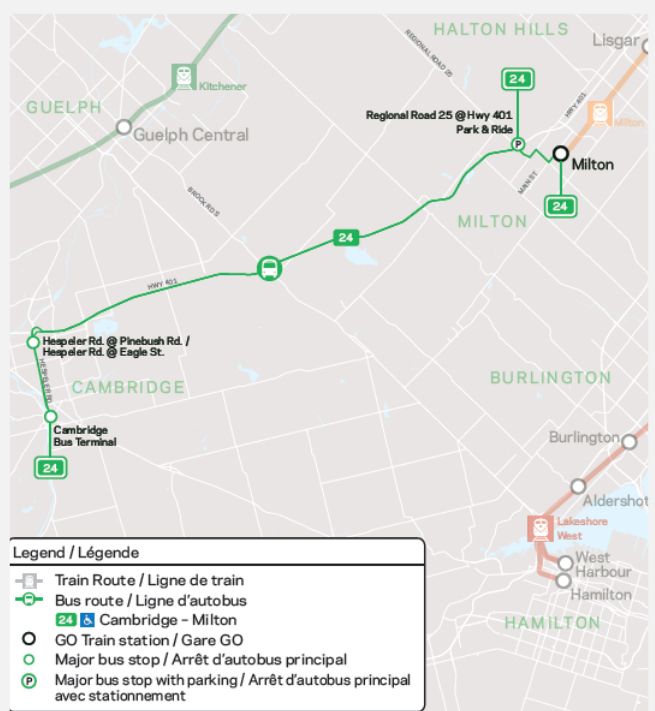
INTRODUCING GO BUS SERVICE TO CAMBRIDGE

The new Route 24 (Cambridge/Milton) service runs on weekdays with four morning and four afternoon trips, along with early-afternoon and two late-evening homebound trips.

Stops are located at Ainsley St. Bus Terminal (35 Ainslie St. S.) in downtown Cambridge, selected stops along Hespeler Rd., the Milton Park & Ride lot and Milton GO to connect with train service.
