



AQUATIC INSTRUCTORS / LIFEGUARDS

The City of Cambridge accepts applications throughout the year and hires motivated and enthusiastic men and women on an as needed basis at the W.G. Johnson Centre and the John Dolson Centre.

The duties of the Aquatic Instructor/Guard are to instruct learn-to-swim and lifesaving levels, guarding public and private swims to ensure the safety of participants through preventative guarding, dealing with incidents, completing work sheets and personal record cards and performing other duties as assigned. Attendance at scheduled staff trainings is mandatory.

Applicants must be 16 years of age or older and have the following **current** certifications: LSS/Red Cross Instructors, Standard First Aid and C.P.R., AED with first aid, National (NLS) certification is preferred for AWSI. A current Police Record Check is required.

The hourly rate of pay is based on qualifications.
