



## **ASSISTANT WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTORS**

The duties of the Aquatic Assistant Water Safety Instructor are to co-instruct learn-to-swim levels. As well they will assist with completing work sheets and personal record cards and performing other duties as assigned.

Applicants must be 15 years of age or older and have the following **current** certifications: Red Cross Assistant Water Safety Instructors, Standard First Aid, C.P.R., AED, Bronze Cross or National (NLS) certification is preferred. A current Police Record Check is required. Attendance at scheduled staff training is mandatory.

The hourly rate of pay is based on qualifications.
