Fall Leaf Program Suspended
Update from the City of Cambridge Public Works Team

Cambridge, Ontario. December 7, 2007...This long, mild fall has meant that trees were dressed with leaves late into the season. From a leaf collection standpoint, it has meant the City of Cambridge program started later than usual.

"While a beautiful sight, it is unusual to have leaves remaining on the trees in November," says Ed Kovacs, Commissioner of Transportation and Public Works.

Unfortunately, now that winter weather has come upon us, the completion of the leaf program is unlikely. This means that residents of north Cambridge may have to wait until the spring for the program to resume.

"If conditions allow us to re-start the program, the Public Works team will begin leaf collection again," says Phil Dechene, Director of Public Works. He notes that if winter persists, collection will happen in the spring with a priority for the citizens of north Cambridge.
