Atria's Wi-Fi Networks in Cambridge Expand Cambridge City Hall Now a "Hotspot"

Cambridge, Ontario. November 20, 2008...Cambridge City Hall is now a hotspot for wireless Internet services offered through Atria Networks. The latest Wi-Fi access point in Cambridge is part of ongoing investments to expand infrastructure to provide coverage in zones throughout the city.

"Wi-Fi opens up a range of support for people to go wireless. Now visitors to City Hall have the option to access the Internet wirelessly enhancing communications at meetings or interaction with City Councillors and staff," says Steven Fairweather, Commissioner of Corporate Services.

The Wi-Fi network is a broadband wireless network that offers high-speed Internet access to subscribers. A subscriber can access email, remote VPN access to corporate networks, or simply surf the Internet using the same portable devices that are already used at the office or home.

"All you need is a standard Wi-Fi certified card and your portable device - a laptop, PDA or smartphone, and you are good to go," says Fairweather. Most laptops and PDAs already have Wi-Fi technology installed by the manufacturer so no other software is generally required.

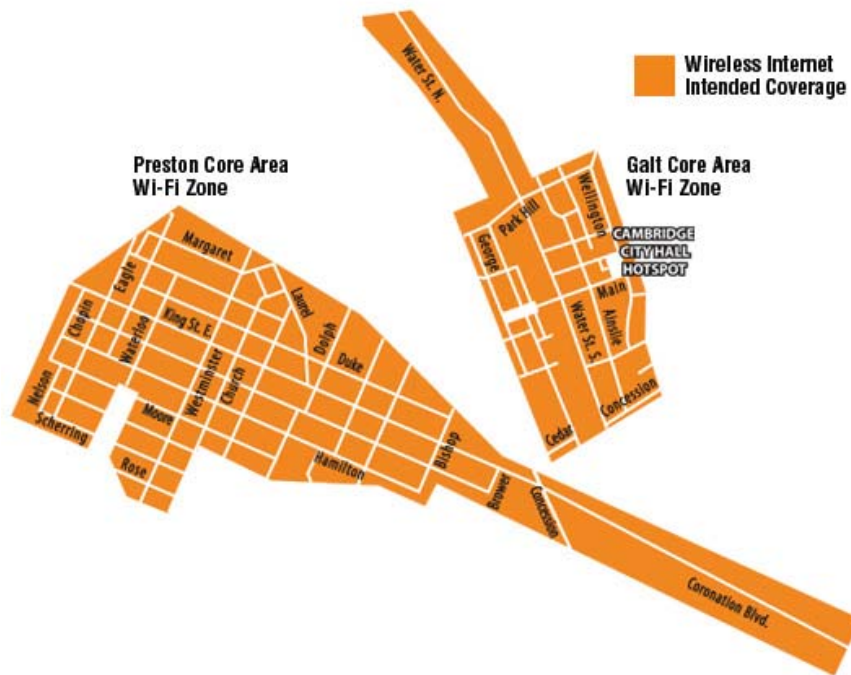

the year with coverage inside as well as some points in the public space. The total coverage area of all of the Wi-Fi areas is approximately 3.3 sq km.
