**Recreational Services Update
Snow Crews in Public Works Keep on Plowing**

Cambridge, Ontario. Friday, February 01, 2008...A number of recreational programs will be impacted as a result of the heavy snow fall and dangerous driving conditions today.

Program Cancellations:

City of Cambridge Centre for the Arts, senior centres and pool facilities will cancel all programs slated for this evening as of 5:30 pm.

Community arenas will remain open, but parents are encouraged to contact their league officials for specific information on game cancellations.

Snow Removal Update From Public Works:

Crews will be working late into the evening. Staff will continue clearing main arteries and Regional Roads within the City of Cambridge and start to plow residential areas until 10pm tonight. Residents are encouraged to keep their vehicles off the roads to facilitate this process. The snow crews will begin again at 7:00 am to finish up residential roads. Standby crews will remain on duty throughout the night to maintain the City's primary roads.

The City of Cambridge focuses on 23 plow routes within the municipality; 8 are considered primary routes which include regional roads and main arteries. The remainder is residential locations and all are a priority for the snow removal team. There's a fleet of 28 plows trucks, 10 of which are equipped with spreaders.
