The City of Cambridge is gearing up to host the 2008 edition of the Waterloo-Wellington Seniors Summer Games.

The event, which is held in Cambridge once every seven years, will be staged May 26 to June 5. This year's games will include a wide range of competitions including badminton, tennis, lawn bowling, swimming euchre, duplicate bridge and solo.

The opening ceremonies will be held May 26 at 11 a.m. at Preston Branch 126, Royal Canadian Legion, 334 Westminster Dr.

The games will run that week from Monday through Thursday and then resume June 2 and conclude June 5 with closing ceremonies back at the Preston legion. The last time the event was held in Cambridge, 647 competitors participated.
