Coun. Pam Wolf has been appointed to sit as a regional representative on TVOntario's advisory board.

Following an interactive discussion session last Friday with Lisa de Wilde, TVO's CEO, and local leaders in education, technology and business, Wolf told the *Times* that she's excited to take on this new role because of the power of positive connections.

Wolf explained that she sometimes attends lectures at the University of Waterloo School of Architecture, and often when she leaves she thinks to herself: "This should be broadcast."

When a good idea is shared in a room of 50 people, there's a whole world outside that may benefit from hearing that same idea, and Wolf - a self-described lifelong learner - said it will be exciting to be a part of an organization that "wants to make you think".
