### Regular Pool Maintenance for the City of Cambridge Options for Community Swimmers During Scheduled Cleanings

Cambridge, Ontario. September 4, 2009...The City of Cambridge will begin a series of pool maintenance operations that will temporarily suspend the following pool operations:

The **W.G. Johnson Centre Pool** at 31 Kribs Street will be closed for regularly scheduled maintenance work from Tuesday September 8th through to Thursday September 10, 2009. The pool will reopen for business on Friday September 11th at 6:00 am. Please note that all other services at the recreation facility will remain open for business during the maintenance procedures.

The **John Dolson Centre** located at 212 South Street will be closed from Sept 5th through to Sept 20th inclusive. Other administrative services including registration and gym programs will continue as usual. This maintenance is also a regular annual program that is scheduled at the end of the peak period to have minimum impact on the swimming public.

Citizen wanting an alternative swim location may consider The Kinsmen Soper Park Pool which is open from 9:30 am to 4:00 pm providing Aquafit classes and recreational swims during this service adjustment period, weather permitting. It's a heated outdoor pool located at 41 Marion Way.
