- Open Saturday October 10th and Sunday October 11th from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. Holiday hours will be in effect on Monday October 12th where citizens may visit the facility between 11:00 am - 4:00 pm.
- There are no lessons or fitness classes on Monday. However, the facility will offer a lane swim from 11:30 am to 1:00 pm; leisure swim runs 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm; and a family swim will happen between 3:00 pm and 4:00 pm. The conditioning centre is open on holiday Monday between 11:00 am and 4:00 pm.
