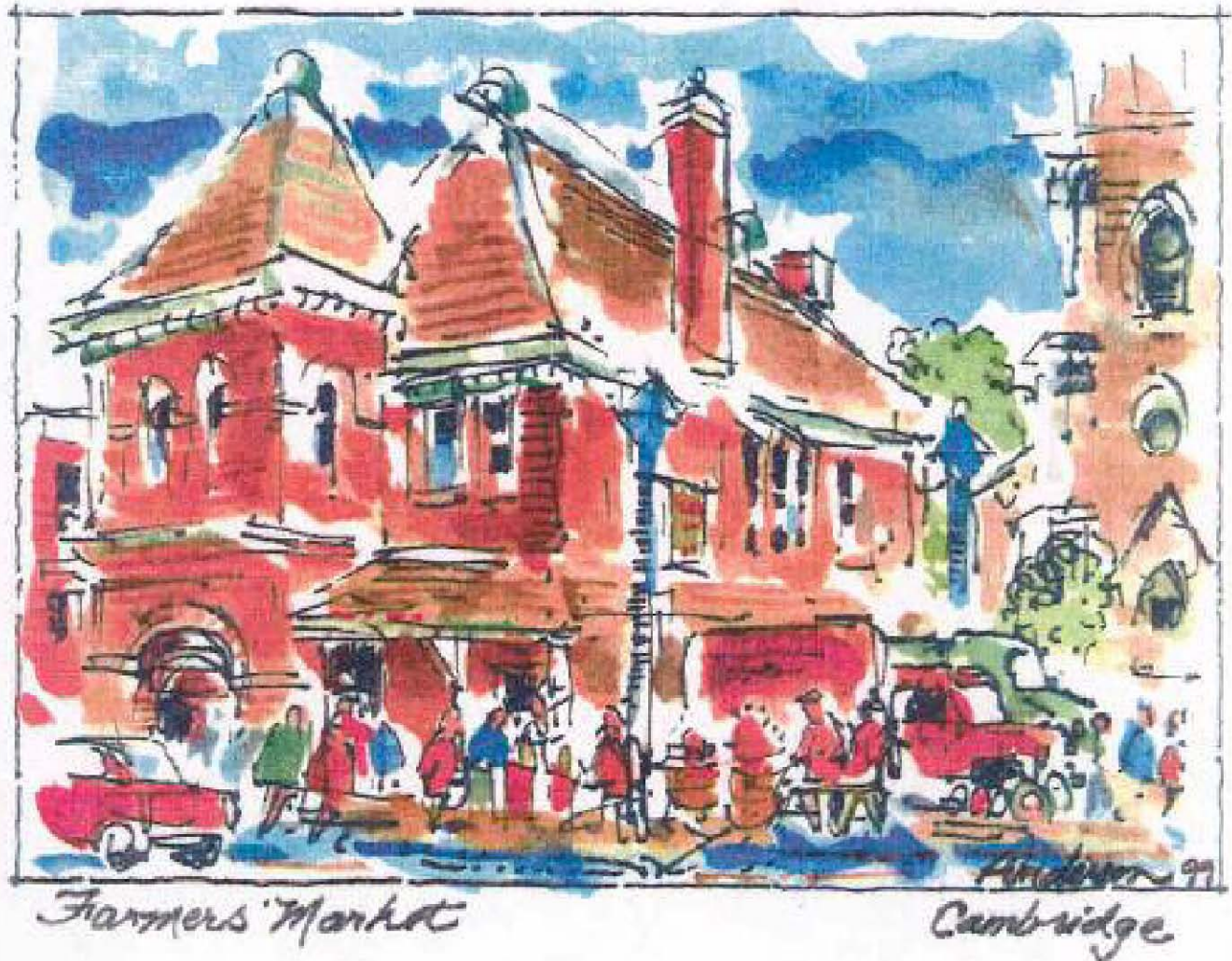

City of Cambridge Heritage Properties Inventory

The City of Cambridge Heritage Properties Inventory is a council endorsed inventory of known built heritage resources¹ in Cambridge. It is a useful guide for the public to identify significant built heritage resources in their community. In addition, staff consults this inventory when processing applications for signage, building permits, development proposals, proposed amendments to the official plan and/or zoning by-law, and consents/variances under consideration by the City's Committee of Adjustment.

The Inventory includes those built heritage resources, which are designated under Part IV and V of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990 and those identified as properties of interest by the Cambridge Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee (MHAC) for their architectural and/or historical significance.

Properties designated under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act are identified with the word **DESIGNATED**. Those properties designated under Part V in either the Main Street or Blair Village Heritage Conservation District are identified with **DESIGNATED (HCD)**. The remaining properties are known as properties of interest.

This document is updated to May 18, 2006 and was endorsed by Cambridge Council on June 12, 2006. The contents have been arranged alphabetically by street name and provide a brief description of the property, its designation status and the community it is located in. This document also includes listings for buildings that have been demolished or relocated as research has been conducted.

Mr. Ross Anderson has generously provided the Heritage Properties Inventory cover art. Mr. Anderson is an architect (retired) and a Cambridge resident who has made many contributions toward the stewardship of our local heritage.

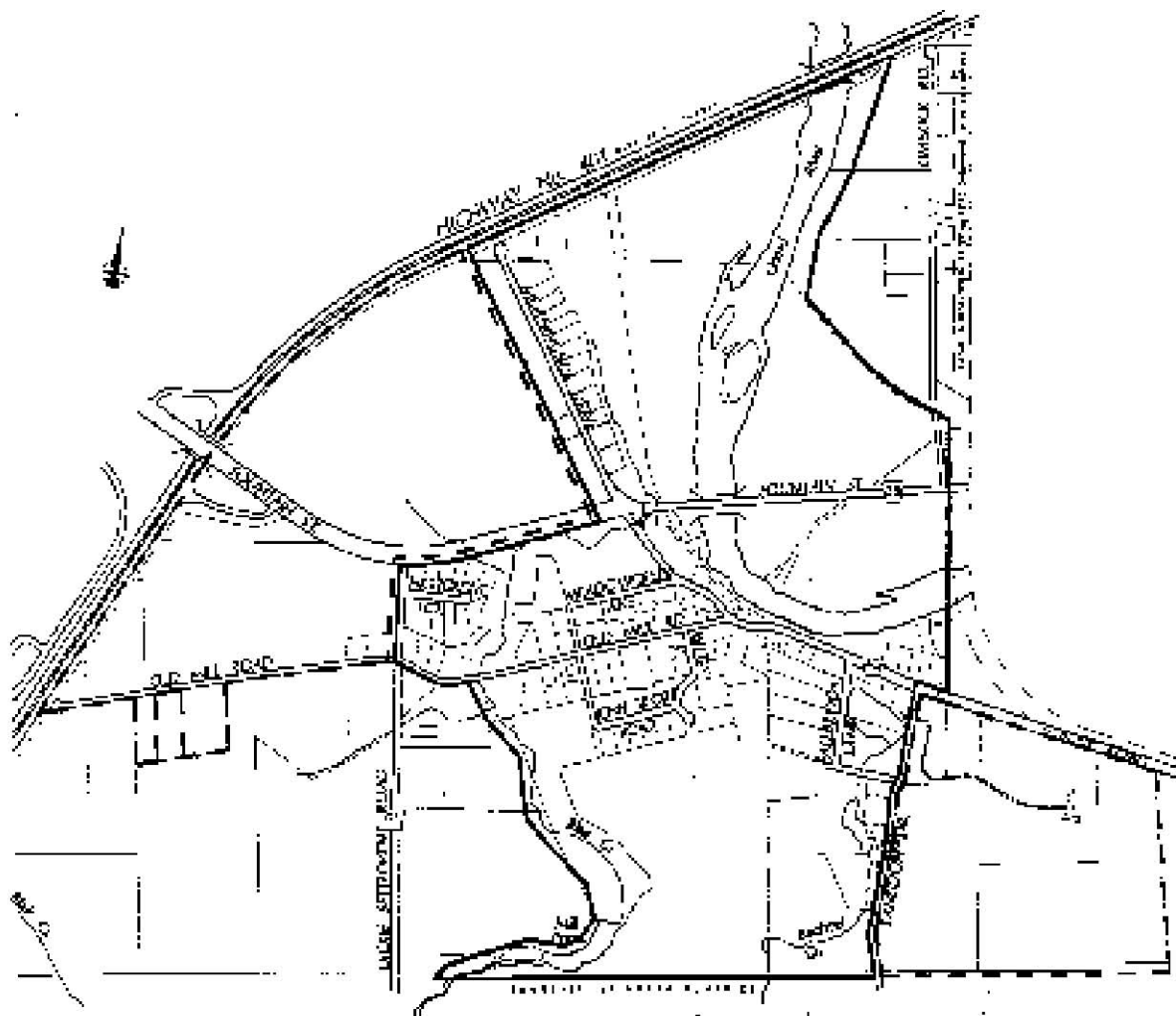
