

BY-LAW NO. 106-10

OF THE

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to provide for advance votes to be held prior to voting day and to repeal By-law 157-06.

WHEREAS Section 43(1) of the Municipal Election Act, S.O., 1996 provides that a municipal council shall pass a by-law establishing one or more dates for an advance vote, and the hours during which voting places shall be open on that date or dates.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT advance votes shall be held on the following dates, hours and locations with respect to the Municipal Election to be held on Monday, October 25, 2010:



