

## **CELINE**

**In May 2007, Barna-Alper Productions selected Cambridge for the filming of several scenes for the T.V. movie "Celine" being produced for CBC. The two-hour movie is based on the life of Canadian Grammy and Juno award-winning pop superstar Celine Dion.**

**Filming locations in Cambridge included a private residence on Henry Street and a farm on Ripplewood Road. The Henry Street location was used as the backdrop for several outdoor scenes. In the evening, the Ripplewood location was used to shoot a spectacular fire scene. The farmhouse was transformed into the "Old Barrel Pub" (owned by Celine's parents) which burned to the ground.**

**The cast include Christine Ghawi (Celine Dion); Enrico Colantoni (Rene Angelil); Jodelle Ferland (young Celine); Louise Pitre (Therese Dion); and Peter MacNeill (Adhemar Dion).**

**The movie was directed by Jeff Woolnough (C.S.I., Battlestar Galactica). The Director of Photography was Miroslaw Baszak; and the Production Designer was Lindsey Hermer-Bell.**
