Applications for additions or corrections to, or deletion of your name from the voters' list including alteration of the individual school support entry shown on the list may be made by completing and filing a form obtainable at the Office of the City Clerk commencing from September 7, 2010 to October 25, 2010 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. (except Saturdays and Sundays) and on October 25, 2010 at the appropriate poll location prior to the close of the poll.

For the 2010 Municipal Election, you will be able to check yourself to see if your name is on the Voters List through a service called "Internet Voter Lookup". The Internet Voter Lookup will allow residents to enter basic personal information into a search screen on our website and receive a "yes" or "no" response as to whether you are on the Voters' List. This service is scheduled to be available on our website as of September 7, 2010.

Are You Planning to Put in a Pool or Hot Tub This Year? Then You Need To Be Aware of The Following Information

A Swimming Pool and Fencing permit is required for the installation of privately-owned in-ground, on-ground, above-ground and inflatable outdoor pools and hot tubs capable of holding 76.2 cm (30 inches) of water or more.

To obtain your permit, a plot plan or survey of your property is required showing the location of the swimming pool and/or hot tub in relation to the property lines and all structures on the property. The drawing must also show the type of fencing that you intend to use, the location of the fence and any other structures or adjacent fences within 1.5 m (5 feet) of the pool fence.

Thinking of Building a Shed or Deck This Year? Then You Need To Be Aware of The Following Information

A building permit is required to construct any structure occupying an area greater than 10m² (107 ft.²). If you plan on building a deck, then a building permit is required for any deck that is 60 cm (2'-0") above grade or more. Please note that regardless of requiring a building permit, the City of Cambridge Zoning By-law would still apply. Please contact the City of Cambridge Zoning Division at 519.740.4650 to enquire about the Cambridge Zoning By-law.

To obtain your building permit, bring along two (2) copies of your working drawings (may need qualified designer) indicating size, spans and dimensions, two (2) copies of your site plan indicating location of proposed construction, and the permit fee to:
