CEAC also coordinates community efforts through the City Green Strategy, Ground Water Guardian, and oversees the City's Natural Heritage Trust Fund. *Members shall not be expected to function as a representative of a particular agency, organization or interest group. Expertise in one or more of the following areas would be particularly desirable: water resources, forestry, biology, climatology, economics, urban design, community development (volunteerism).*
