



DOCUMENTARIES

- **The Melville Cafe was the location for a documentary filmed by YAP Films (based in Toronto) on August 17, 2009. The co-producers for the documentary reside in London, England.**
- **The Learning Channel (TLC) filmed a portion of a documentary they are producing on Kenadie Jourdin-Bromley at the Cambridge Farmers' Market on July 1, 2009. Kenadie has a rare form of dwarfism called Primordial Dwarfism. TLC has filmed Kenadie in the past, and this filming is a continuation of their documentary on her life. Part 2 is scheduled to air in the Fall, 2009.**
- **Les Productions R Charbonneau filmed portions of an Educational Youth Show titled "J'ai Mon Voyage" on Friday, May 12th, 2006. The film areas included Queen's Square, Mill Race Park and the river walkway. The Production Company originated from Ottawa. The television production will air on French TVO in September, 2006.**
- **CBC Radio-Canada from Toronto, Ontario filmed a variety of outdoor winter scenes in and around Cambridge in early March, 2005 for a ten part documentary on the "History of Hockey in Canada".**
- **TV Ontario's production of "An Artist of the Grand: Journey through Festival Country" included our Riverfest and Cambridge Highland Games events. Filming took place in July, 2000. The documentary will be aired on TVO sometime in October 2000. The program is an examination of the history, artistic legacy and festivals of the communities along the Grand River. The Producer is Aaron Lam of Pontoon Man Films.**
