The CBS TV miniseries "Haven" was filmed in part at the old CMC building on Concession Street in downtown Cambridge in July 2000. "Haven" stars Natasha Richardson as Ruth Gruber, a United States government official who helped bring almost 1,000 holocaust survivors to America at the end of the Second World War. The film also stars Martin Landau and Anne Bancroft.



The rubble at the rear of the CMC property doubled as war-ravaged Naples, Italy. According to Assistant Location Managers for Oswega Productions, "it is hard to find a World War II scene, specifically for 1945 and bombed looking - the CMC site was perfect, lying where it fell. It actually looked bombed".

"Haven" was produced by Oswega Productions and directed by John Gray.
