HIGH SCHOOL TEAM OF THE YEAR

GUIDELINES

1. Officially sanctioned Waterloo County Secondary School Athletic Association and District 8 sport.
2. Minimum requirement is WCSSAA/District 8/CWOSSA Champion.
3. Junior or senior teams may be eligible.
4. There will be no discrimination between sexes.
5. Sportsmanship, behaviour and deportment are to be considered.
6. A team is defined as more than two (2) players.
7. The award is to be awarded once per year.
8. Each school may nominate ONE (1) team.
9. Each school may provide the Cambridge Sports Awards Selections Committee with background information on the team that they have nominated.
10. Awarded at the annual Sports Awards Banquet for the previous school year.
