The Summer Playground program is for children 3 - 12 years of age and offers activities such as arts, crafts, games, swimming, music, entertainers, and off-site trips all led by qualified Leaders, and Leaders-in-Training. The Playground program takes place at various sites and school locations across the Cambridge. Not all sites offer programming for children of all ages and/or off-site trips. All programs offer weekly sessions, and every week includes new activities.

What you need to know when REGISTERING YOUR CHILD ...

Registration dates and program locations for the various sites are listed on the pages that follow and are subject to change, pending approval.

- There are a limited number of spaces available per program, so you are encouraged to register at the times listed.
- Pre-school children must be toilet trained prior to program registration
- At registration you will be required to provide the following information: birth date; phone numbers (home / business / cell) of parents or guardian and an alternative contact; any medical or allergy information of which we should be aware.
- Subsidies are available for all programs
- **The deadline for Summer Playground registration is June 6th. Register early!**

Please be advised that **children with special needs** will be asked upon registration if they require additional support or specialized accommodations in order to participate in program. If support is required Inclusion Services will be in contact with the family to arrange the details. Starting in 2011, support will no longer be managed through an applications process. All children are encouraged to register for the summer program of their choice. Programs will be staffed according to overall participant needs.






Parents are reminded that The City of Cambridge has restricted peanuts and peanut products from our Summer Playground programs because some of our participants have severe allergies to these products. Please do not bring peanuts or nut products to camp.
