

BY-LAW NO. 195-12

OF THE

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a By-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge
determining that the Line Fence Act does not apply to lands
within the City of Cambridge

WHEREAS *the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., c. 25, Section 98* enables local municipalities to provide that the *Line Fences Act R.S.O. 1990. c. L 17* does not apply to all or any part of the municipality.


AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Cambridge deems it expedient to provide that the *Line Fences Act* shall not apply to the entire geographic region of the Municipality.


NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This By-law is enacted pursuant to Section 98 of *The Municipal Act, 2001*.
2. The *Line Fences Act* shall not apply to the Municipality.
3. That this By-law comes into force on the day it is passed and enacted.
