



BY-LAW 100 - 17

Of the

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to amend By-law 189-13 (Lot Maintenance By-law) in regard to the location of Donation Collection Boxes and the service of notices.

**WHEREAS** By-law 43-17 was passed on 28 March 2017 to amend By-law 189-13 (Lot Maintenance By-law) in regard to Donation Collection Boxes;

**AND WHEREAS** By-law 43-17 contained an error in regard to the location of Donation Collection Boxes;

**AND WHEREAS** By-law 189-13 does not set out the manner of service of notices of contravention issued under the By-law;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

1. That section 11A.1 (c) of By-law 189-13, as amended by By-law 43-17, be amended by the insertion of the word “not” after the word “is”.
2. That By-law 189-13, as amended by By-law 43-17, be further amended by inserting the following section:

**“15. SERVICE**

15.1 A notice required by this By-law to be served may be served

- (a) personally, or
- (b) by regular mail or by registered mail sent to the last known address of the person to whom notice is to be given or to that person's agent for service, or
- (c) by posting the notice in a conspicuous location on the property if the regular mail or the registered mail containing the notice is returned to the Municipal Law Enforcement Officer.

15.2 If the notice is served by regular mail or by registered mail, the service shall be deemed to have been made on the fifth day after the day of mailing unless the person to whom the notice is given or that person's agent for service establishes that, acting in good faith, through absence, accident, illness or other unintentional cause the notice was not received until a later date."

- 3. This by-law shall be deemed to come into force and effect on Monday 1 May 2017.
