



BY-LAW NO. 82-13

OF THE

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to amend Schedule B of By-law 184-06 to establish a system of disabled parking. (DISABLED PARKING BY-LAW) – SCHEDULE “B” AMENDMENTS

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge passed By-law No. 184-06 on the 18th day of September, 2006.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, Section 11(2), Table, Paragraphs 1 and 8, authorize by-laws with respect to parking;

WHEREAS Section 49 and 102 of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 provide for the passing of by-laws for exempting disabled persons from parking by-law provisions;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Cambridge has passed By-law No. 184-06 pursuant to Section 49 and 102 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25;
