

BY-LAW NO. 163-96  
OF THE  
CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge  
to amend the City of Cambridge By-Law No. 313-86 to  
regulate open fires, and to repeal By-law No. 190-88.

WHEREAS Council has enacted By-law No. 313-86 pursuant to section 210(28) of the  
Municipal Act, R.S.O., 1980, c.302;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend By-law No. 313-86;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE  
CITY OF CAMBRIDGE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT section 14 of By-law No. 313-86 is hereby amended by adding section 14(a)  
as follows:

“Notwithstanding the provisions of the Ontario Fire Code, no person shall light,  
ignite or start, or permit to be lighted, ignited or started a fire in a grill or barbecue  
for the purpose of cooking food on a balcony of any building containing two (2) or  
more dwelling units.”

2. THAT By-law No. 190-88 is hereby repealed.
