1.0 INDIGENOUS ENGAGEMENT

Indigenous Engagement was initiated as part of the Stage 3 assessment of the subject property (ASI 2019) in accordance with the *Standards and Guidelines for Consultant Archaeologists* (MTC 2011a) and *Engaging Aboriginal Communities in Archaeology: A Draft Technical Bulletin for Consultant Archaeologists in Ontario* (MTC 2011b).

Given that the study area is within the traditional lands of the Six Nations of the Grand River (SNEC), the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation (MCFN) and the Haudenosaunee Development Institute (HDI), an engagement process was undertaken. To that end, as per the preferences of the nations, all entered into an agreement directly with the proponent.

During the course of the fieldwork undertaken during this Stage 3 assessment representatives from three Nations were present on site for fulsome participation. The Six Nations of the Grand River were represented by Alex Henry. The Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation were represented by Kris Jonathan, Chantel Laform, Rasondra Mendes, Alison Laform, Joleen Secord, and Leah Sault. The Haudenosaunee were represented by Tyler Hill.

A summary of activity and formal communication relating to Stage 3 assessment of the Bergey site between ASI and the SNEC, MCFN and HDI is available in Table 1. Communication with SNEC, MCFN and HDI regarding this project continued on a regular basis in the form of in field consultation and emails.

A copy of the Stage 3 Site-Specific Assessment report with results, maps and recommendations will be circulated to the Six Nations of the Grand River, the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation and the Haudenosaunee Development Institute.
