



BY-LAW 19-181

of the

CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the City to require a By-Election to fill the vacancy for the office of City Councillor representing Ward 7.

**WHEREAS** Section 259 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended (the Act), establishes that the office of a member of council of a municipality becomes vacant upon the death of a member;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 262 (1) of the Act, states that if the office of a member of council becomes vacant upon the death of a member, the council shall declare the office to be vacant at one of its next two meetings;

**AND WHEREAS** in accordance with Section 262 (1) of the Act, Council of the City of Cambridge declared the office of Ward 7 City Councillor to be vacant on November 5, 2019;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 263 of the Act, establishes that where a vacancy occurs in the office of a member of Council of a municipality, the Council may pass a by-law to require that a by-election be held to fill the vacancy in the office of City Councillor – Ward 7;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

1. THAT a by-election be held to fill the vacancy for the office of City Councillor representing Ward 7 in the City of Cambridge;
2. THAT said by-election be conducted in accordance with Section 65 of the *Municipal Elections Act*, R.S.O. 1996;
3. THAT the by-election be administered via in-person voting only;
4. THAT Voting Day be Monday, March 23, 2020;
5. THAT this By-law shall come into full force on the day it is passed.
