**2020 MUNICIPAL BY-ELECTION**

**RE: Certificate of Maximum Campaign Expenses as of December 18, 2019**

Please find attached the Certificate of Maximum Campaign Expenses, as of December 18, 2019, for candidate expenses and their own campaign expenses.

In accordance with section 88.20 (12) of the Municipal Elections Act (MEA), 1996, upon filing a nomination, the Clerk will provide each candidate with a preliminary calculation of maximum candidate expenses and a preliminary calculation of the permitted amount of contribution to a candidate’s own campaign. This figure is based upon the number of electors on the Voters’ List as of Nomination Day of the previous election.

At least sixty (60) days before voting day, the Clerk will receive the preliminary updated elector list from the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MEA 65(5)). After updates are made to the list, the Clerk will provide each candidate with a final calculation of the maximum spending limit and a final calculation of permitted contributions to their own campaign.

The higher amount in each calculation will become the candidate’s official spending limit and personal contribution limit.

Candidates are encouraged to review the City of Cambridge’s 2020 Municipal By-Election material, in conjunction with the Municipal Elections Act, particularly with respect to campaign contributions and expenses.
