2020 MUNICIPAL BY-ELECTION

RE: Certificate of Maximum Campaign Expenses as of December 18, 2019

Please find attached the Certificate of Maximum Campaign Expenses, as of December 18, 2019, for candidate expenses and their own campaign expenses.

In accordance with section 88.21 (12) of the Municipal Elections Act (MEA), 1996, upon filing a nomination, the Clerk will provide each third party advertiser with a preliminary calculation of maximum campaign expenses. This figure is based upon the number of electors on the Voters’ List as of Nomination Day of the previous election.

At least sixty (60) days before voting day, the Clerk will receive the preliminary updated elector list from the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MEA 65(5)). After updates are made to the list, the Clerk will provide each third party advertiser with a final calculation of the maximum spending limit.

The higher amount in each calculation will become the official spending limit.

Third party advertisers are encouraged to review the City of Cambridge’s 2020 Municipal By-Election material, in conjunction with the Municipal Elections Act, particularly with respect to campaign contributions and expenses.
