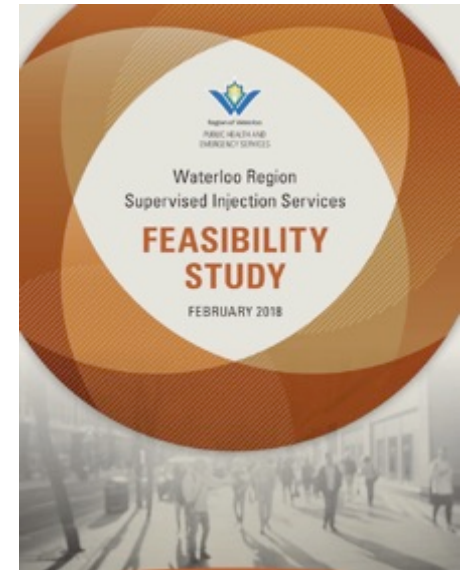


Waterloo Regional Public Health Feasibility Study

- In February, 2018, Waterloo Regional Public Health completed a feasibility study on supervised injection services.
- The study included:
 - A review of data sources related to opioid use in Waterloo Region;
 - In-person surveys with people with experience of injection drug use;
 - Key informant interviews with harm reduction service providers; and,
 - Information and consultation sessions, including an online survey to gather public input.
- The study provided the basis to inform the process of identifying potential CTS Sites, such as the approved CTS Site at 150 Duke Street West.



150 Duke Street West, Kitchener

- The CTS Site located at 150 Duke Street West is in a freestanding building (approximately 6,500 square feet) in a central location of the city.
- The CTS Site at 150 Duke Street West includes:
 - Safe consumption;
 - Harm reduction supply distribution;
 - Wound care;
 - Sharps disposal; and,
 - Referral pathways to social services, primary care and treatment supports.
- In November, 2019, 699 visits were recorded at the CTS Site.
