

Canadian Navigable Waters Act

The City of Cambridge hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Navigable Waters Registry pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* for public comment described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 10(1)(b) of the said Act, *The City of Cambridge* has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry number 10034, a description of the following work, its site and plans:

The existing one-lane steel truss bridge will be repurposed as an active transportation crossing of the Speed River. The improvements to the existing bridge include removal of concrete, removal of guide rails, removal of damaged steel bracing members, concrete patch repairs, concrete curbs, steel reinforcing and bracing, crack sealing, and new bicycle railings.

The existing bridge is across *The Speed River* at *Black Bridge Road, Cambridge*, the coordinates of each side of the bridge are 43.450936, -80.298140 (east side) and 43.450979, -80.298676 (west side).
