


THE STUDY

The City of Cambridge has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study to assess the preferred sanitary servicing strategy for future sanitary pumping station requirements within the Dover Street Pumping Station catchment area. The pumping station, located at 932 Dover Street, was constructed in 1969. Various upgrades and maintenance activities have been performed since it was commissioned; however, the station is nearing the end of its useful life. Considering the age and current condition of the pumping station and the anticipated increase in future flows, the City of Cambridge is undertaking this study to determine the most feasible way to address future sanitary pumping station requirements.



THE PROCESS

This study is being planned as a Schedule “B” Class EA, satisfying Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Engineers Association (MEA) Class EA process, which is a planning process approved under Ontario’s Environmental Assessment Act. This study will define the problems/opportunities associated with the pumping station, develop and evaluate alternative strategies, determine the most feasible solution, and identify methods to avoid or minimize impacts to the community and natural environment.

PUBLIC CONSULTATION

The City of Cambridge encourages the public and stakeholders to participate in this planning process. The City will be hosting a Public Information Centre (PIC) later this fall to obtain input on the preliminary results of the study. Notification of the PIC will be advertised in the local community newspaper and notices mailed to residents and businesses located within the immediate study area.
