

Extended On-street Parking (PE3) Fact Sheet

Geometric Requirements:

- Where the pavement width is less than 10.0 metres a PE3 will only be considered where parking is prohibited on one side.
- Residences with driveways immediately adjacent to intersections, where parked vehicles may constitute a sight line obstruction, are not eligible.
- To allow parking in the centre of a cul-de-sac turning bulb curbside parking will be prohibited.

Important Facts:

- Extended on-street parking can impede waste collection and road maintenance.
- PE3's for cul-de-sac turning bulbs are suspended between November 1st and March 31st to accommodate snow storage.
- All PE3's will be suspended during winter snow events. However, vehicles will be permitted to park across sidewalks during snow events.
- Extended on-street parking is difficult to enforce (for vehicles parked in excess of 24 hours) as vehicles must be chalked and ticketed by the same Parking Enforcement Officer.
- It may be difficult for visitors to find on-street parking due to residents parking in the extended parking area.
- Residents from nearby streets may park in the extended parking area on your street.
- Additional signs and posts may be required, if extended parking is implemented on your street.
