PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE (PIC) No. 4**

This Notice is to advise interested parties that the City is planning a Public Information Centre (PIC) to provide an update on study progress, present the preliminary preferred alternative, and provide an opportunity to discuss the project with City staff and the Project Team.

The study is being conducted in accordance with the requirements for a Schedule 'B' project as described in the Municipal Engineers Association's Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) document (October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 and 2015), which is approved under the *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act*. A key component of the study is consultation with interested stakeholders (public, landowners and regulatory agencies). The City has hosted three previous PIC's in 2012, 2013 and 2016 at which time background investigations, management alternatives and an evaluation of alternatives were presented. Significant feedback was received from the public and stakeholders during the study regarding the evaluation of alternatives. Over the most recent period the City has considered additional alternatives, revisited the evaluation and undertook additional consultation with key stakeholders and agency partners. This additional phase of the study is now complete and the City is looking for feedback from the public on the updated assessment, and the preliminary preferred management alternative for Riverside Dam.

- 8:00 pm – Storyboards & one-on-one discussion period; an opportunity for individuals to view the storyboards and discuss the project with City staff and the consulting team in an informal format
