**Re: Covid-19 and 2020 Construction Plans for Cambridge St & Park Hill Rd.
Reconstruction, City of Cambridge (Contract 20-09)**

This letter provides an update to the information letter dated March 30, 2020 on planned reconstruction of Cambridge Street (Park Hill Rd to Dundas St) and Park Hill Road (Ainslie St to Wellington St).

Following the updated essential workplace list provided by the Province on April 3rd, 2020, the original planned construction start date was temporarily delayed. A coordinated review with the Region of Waterloo and member municipalities was undertaken based on this announcement. The City has confirmed through this review that Selkirk and Tait Street Reconstruction is deemed to be a critical infrastructure project.

The City is proceeding with this project, with an approximate updated start date of April 20, 2020. The construction work will be on Park Hill Road.
