To Property Owners and Residents:

Re: Salisbury Avenue Reconstruction, City of Cambridge (Contract T21-19)

The City of Cambridge will be proceeding with the Reconstruction of Salisbury Avenue (Grand Avenue to the end at Highland Public School). Reconstruction will include the replacement of all underground utilities and surface works including: sanitary sewers, storm sewers, watermains, services to property line, asphalt, curbs and sidewalks.

Sousa Concrete Limited will be completing this work which is expected to begin on or about April 5, 2021. The Contractor will start by installing a temporary watermain, followed by removals of existing infrastructure and then the full reconstruction work will begin. The construction is planned to take approximately 180 working days to complete, which would be until approximately the end of August 2022. Weather and other unexpected delays could extend the completion of the work.

To minimize disruption and facilitate access as much as possible, the reconstruction will be completed in five (5) stages. The stages will generally be as follows:

- Stage 1 – Grand Ave to Laneway 164 (the laneway between Crescent Pl and Lansdowne Rd);
- Stage 2 – Laneway 164 to Laneway 157 (the laneway between Lansdowne Rd and Brant Rd); and
- Stage 3 – Laneway 157 to Aberdeen Lane (the laneway between Brant Rd and Victoria Park); and
- Stage 4 – Aberdeen Lane to Forest Rd; and
- Stage 5 – Forest Rd to the end (Highland Public School).

Stage 4 and Stage 5 are tentatively planned to take place in 2022.



The City recognizes that some residents may have concerns with construction moving forward during the COVID-19 pandemic.
