### Re: **Invitation to Attend Public Information Centre #3 for Salisbury Avenue Reconstruction**

The City is proposing to make changes to the proposed design as presented at Public Information Centre #2 (PIC #2) on May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018 for Salisbury Avenue from Grand Avenue South to dead end at Highland Public School. At this meeting, no sidewalk widening was being proposed as required by Provincial Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) in consideration of the Dickson Hill Heritage Plan.

Upon further review and consultation, it has been determined that sidewalk widening to accommodate the Provincial AODA will be required. Sidewalks will be widened towards streetline and not towards property line. This will result in a small narrowing (0.3m) of the boulevard. No further changes to the design presented in 2018 are being proposed (street widths to be maintained, sidewalk not moving closer to property line). Salisbury Avenue is tentatively scheduled for construction in 2021, subject to budget considerations.

You are invited to attend Public Information Centre #3 to review the revised proposed plans. There will not be a formal presentation at the meeting. Instead, this will be a 'drop in' style Public Information Centre that will provide you with an opportunity to review the project in detail, and ask questions of City staff. Staff from the Engineering and Planning Departments will be available to review the project and answer questions.

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**How has the proposed design changed since Public Information Centre #2 held on May 16, 2018?**

***Existing sidewalks to be widened from 1.2m wide to 1.5m wide for Salisbury Avenue***

The project team proposed not to replace/widen the existing sidewalk on Salisbury Avenue at PIC #2. Upon further review and consultation it was determined that an exemption to the AODA may not be warranted, as there would be no major impact to Heritage features (light standards, trees etc.)

The design has been revised to widen all existing 1.2m wide sidewalk to 1.5m wide. The back of sidewalk location will remain and the boulevard width between the curb and sidewalk will be narrowed by 0.3m.
