# Notice of Water Disruption

North Rock Group is working for the City of Cambridge in your community to upgrade the existing watermain located on **McLaren Avenue**. To complete the work, fire service to your property will be temporarily turned off on **Wednesday May 25<sup>th</sup> at approximately 8:00 AM**. Due to the nature of the connections, it will not be restored until late May 25<sup>th</sup> or early May 26<sup>th</sup>.

Before the water is turned off, please make arrangements to have water available to use. We suggest filling bottles and containers with drinking water and filling sinks and tubs for other water uses. If your building has a sprinkler system and/or standpipe and hose system, these systems will not operate as designed when the water supply to the building is shut down. Therefore, you should take all necessary steps to ensure the fire safety of your premises during the water shut-down.

We will work to restore water service as soon as possible. When water service is restored, please run water for a few minutes to clear any air bubbles.

The work on the watermain has been planned to be as brief as possible; however, if the water service shut off will be longer than the times noted the on-site staff will keep in touch.

We understand that water service interruptions can be disruptive. We thank you for your patience and apologize for any inconvenience as we complete this vital work.
