BY-LAW 55-18

of the

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being an Interim Control By-law for the City of Cambridge to prohibit Supervised Consumption Facilities and/or Temporary Overdose Prevention.

WHEREAS the Council for The Corporation of the City of Cambridge has passed a resolution directing that a study be undertaken in respect of the land use planning policies and regulations to be used in siting Supervised Consumption Facilities and Temporary Overdose Prevention sites in the City of Cambridge;

AND WHEREAS Section 38 of the Planning Act, RSO, 1990, c.P.13, as amended, grants a municipality the authority to pass an interim control by-law;

AND WHEREAS the Council for The Corporation of the City of Cambridge has deemed it necessary and expedient to pass such a by-law;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows;

1. THAT this By-law shall be entitled the "Supervised Consumption Facilities and/or Temporary Overdose Prevention Sites Interim Control By-law".
2. For the purposes of this By-law:
 - a) "Council" shall mean the Council of The Corporation of the City of Cambridge;
 - b) "City" shall mean The Corporation of the City of Cambridge; and
 - c) "Interim Control Area" shall mean all lands within the three core areas and all lands within 500 metres surrounding the core areas as defined in the City of Cambridge Official Plan 2012 and as shown on Schedules 'A', 'B' and 'C', attached to and forming part of this by-law in the City of Cambridge.
3. THAT the provisions of this By-law shall only apply to the establishment of any Supervised Consumption Facilities and/or Temporary Overdose Prevention Sites or any similar type of use.

4. Notwithstanding any other by-law to the contrary, no person shall, within the Interim Control Area:

- (i) use any land, building or structure for a Supervised Consumption Facility and/or a Temporary Overdose Prevention or any similar type of use; or
- (ii) be permitted to construct, alter or expand any building or structure for use as a Supervised Consumption Facility and/or a Temporary Overdose Prevention Site or any similar type of use.

5. Definitions:

Supervised Consumption Facility: a facility that has received an exemption from the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act, where people can bring their pre-obtained illicit drugs to consume in a sterile and safe environment. These sites have equipment and trained staff present to oversee a person's drug consumption and assist in the event of an overdose or other health risk. These facilities may offer additional health and drug-related support services. These facilities are intended to provide such services on an ongoing, rather than temporary, basis.


Temporary Overdose Prevention Site: a temporary facility that has received an exemption from the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act, where people can bring their pre-obtained illicit drugs to consume in a sterile and safer environment. These sites have equipment and trained staff present to oversee a person's drug consumption and assist in the event of an overdose or other health risk. Unlike supervised consumption sites, these facilities are to be temporary in nature, existing for one year or less.

6. If any provision or requirement of this By-law or the application thereof to any person shall to any extent be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this By-law or the application of such provision or requirement to all persons other than those to which it is held to be invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected thereby and each provision and requirement of this By-law shall be separately valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.


7. This By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the final passing thereof by Council and shall be in effect until 11:59 p.m. local time on April 10, 2019, unless otherwise extended in accordance with the provisions of the Planning Act, RSO, 1990, c.P.13, as amended.

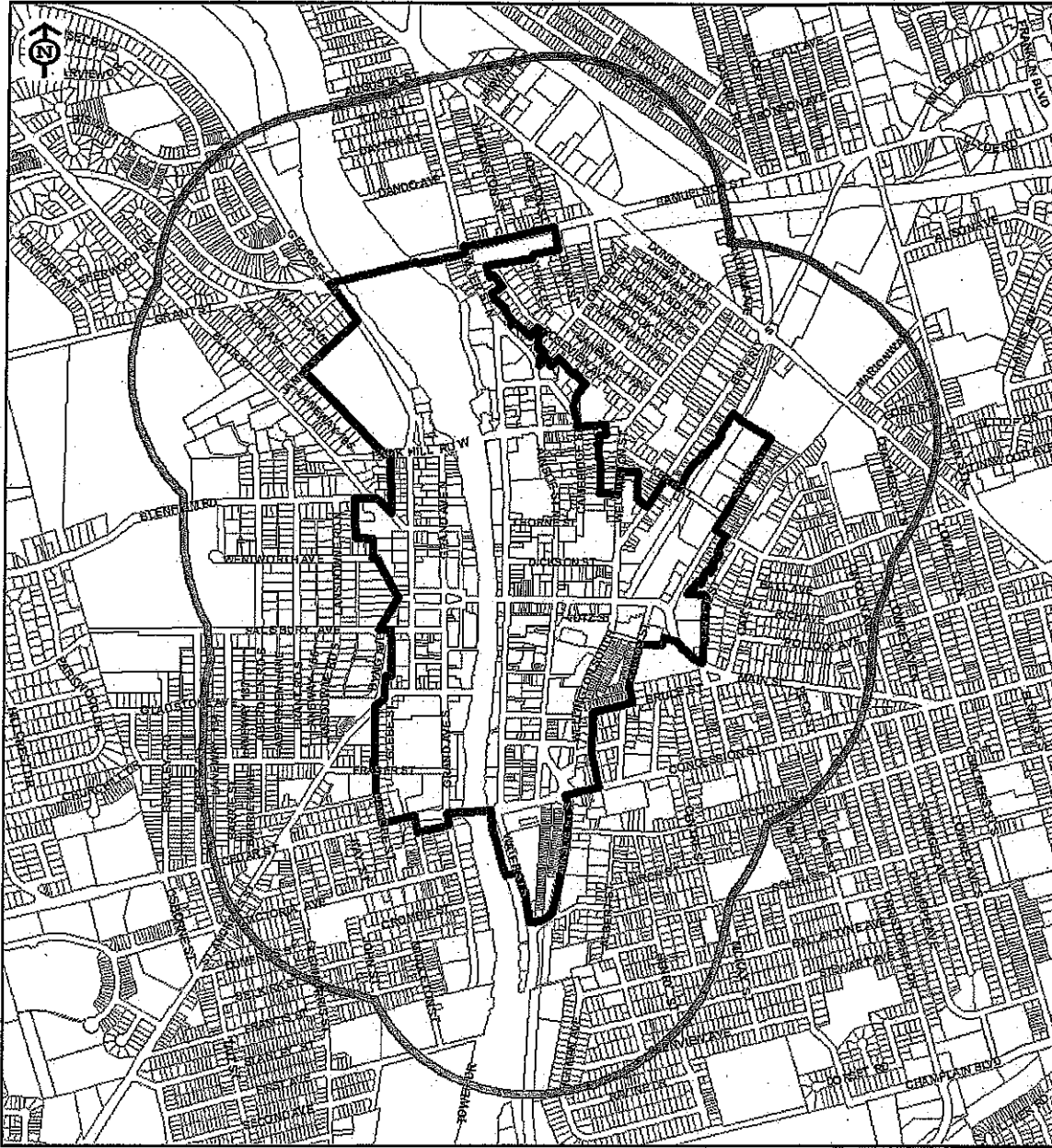

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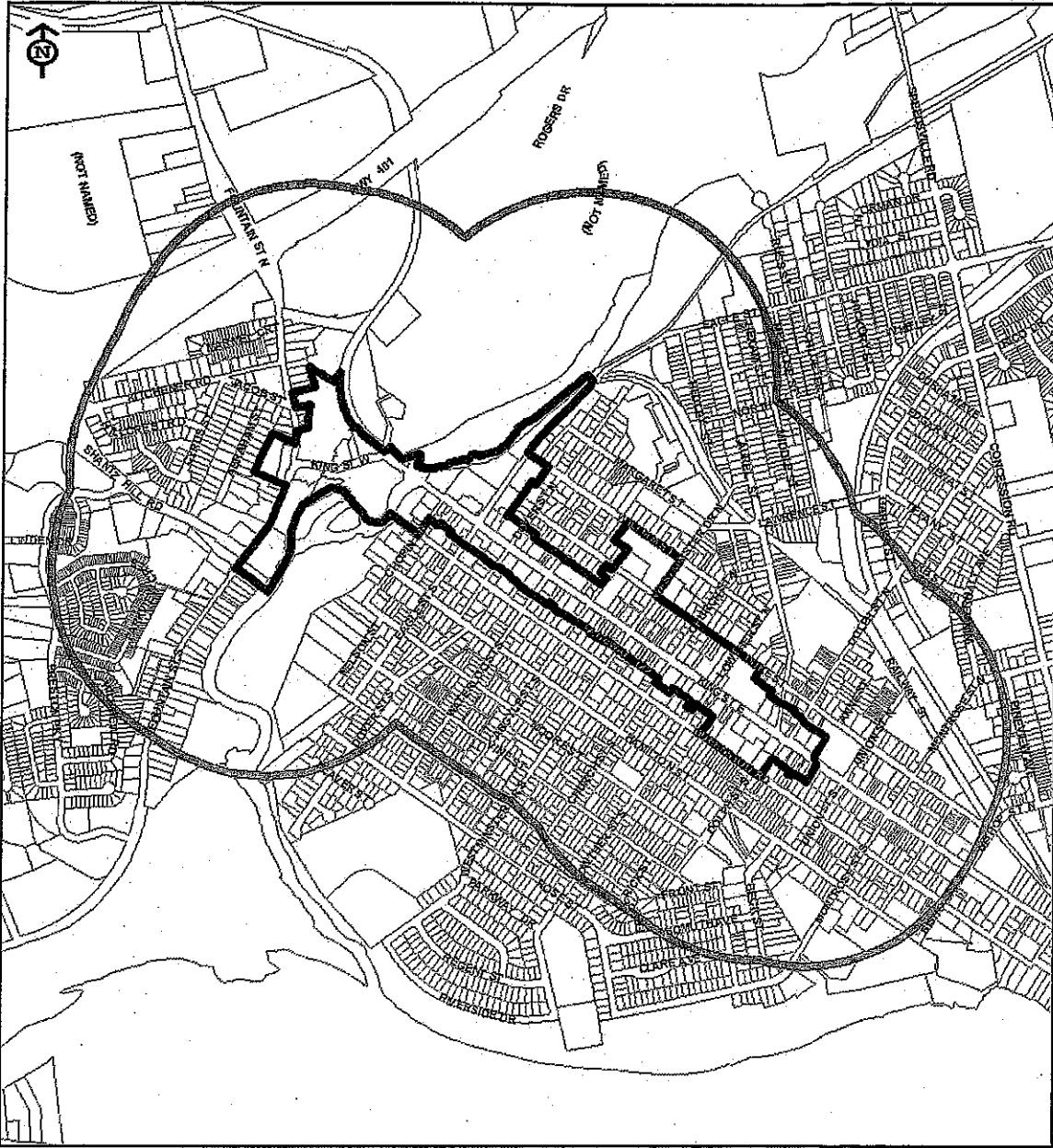


This is Schedule A attached to and forming part of

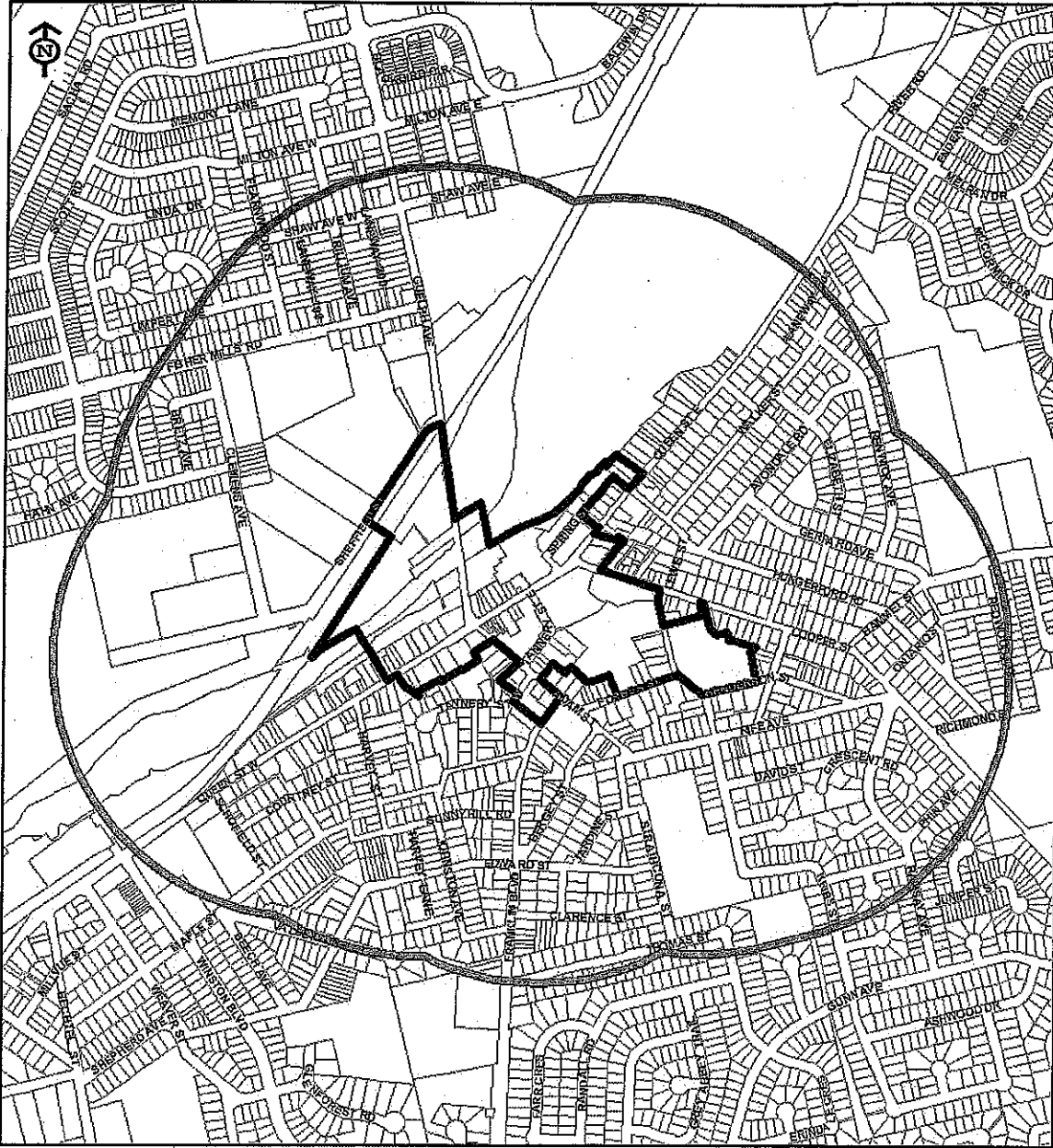


This is Schedule B attached to and forming part of By-law
