Is your child "Program Ready"?

To support the success, safety and inclusion of all individuals registered and participating in City of Cambridge programs, it is important that participants attending these programs are "Program Ready".



This form helps staff to gauge the level of support that will meet your child's needs so we can select the best program for you and your child.

Please tell us if your child is

- Able to take direction and instruction from a staff person
- Comfortable and able to interact in a group environment
- Able to participate in the program. Participation in programs is based on the child's individual needs; however, it is asked that participants can demonstrate an ability to participate in at least 50% of the program
- Able to interact and participate in the program in a way that is safe for themselves and others

All children need to be "Program Ready" when participating in City run programs, either independently or with one on one support.

Our goal is to provide fun and safe programs for your child. Staff have been trained in a variety of behaviour management techniques to encourage positive behaviour and self-discipline. If a child is causing harm to himself/herself or to someone else or is being unsafe, staff may need to intervene. Our priority is your child's safety and success.
