

## Volunteer Position Description

**Volunteer Position:** Youth Artist (12-18 years), Youth Arts Week Exhibition  
**Reporting To:** Youth Recreation Coordinator  
**Location:** Cambridge Centre for the Arts, 60 Dickson St, Cambridge

### Objective:

- Working with local artist and visual arts instructor Kari Mullin youth volunteers will contribute to the completion of an individual and collaborative art piece to be displayed at Cambridge City Hall during Youth Arts Week, May 1<sup>st</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup>. Participants will engage in the learning and use of print making to create a personalized t-shirt (March 16<sup>th</sup>) and a collaborative piece (March 18<sup>th</sup>) with a theme of belonging.

### Responsibilities:

- Provide artistic skills to the completion of art work to be included in the Youth Arts Week display at Cambridge City Hall.

### Time Commitment:

- Participation in one or two days of workshops being held during March Break. The workshops are scheduled to take place on March 16<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> from 10 am – 2 pm.
- As a follow-up to the initial workshop offerings over March Break there is potential opportunity for further participation to be scheduled for the volunteer-based programming to complete pieces if required.

### Training and Orientation:

- Volunteer participation will be guided through Kari Mullin, local artist and instructor.

### Benefits:

- Volunteer hour contributions can contribute to student completion of required secondary school community service requirements.

### Screen Requirements:

- A Volunteer Agreement will require completion prior to participation. The Volunteer Agreement will be provided through the Youth Recreation Coordinator prior to participation.
