

TREE DEDICATION PROGRAM



The Forestry Operations Department is pleased to offer a Commemorative Tree Planting Program. This program may be used as a form of remembrance of a loved one, celebration of a birth, honoring a retiree, or any other event, which you feel should be commemorated by a living tribute. Trees will be planted in approved areas within City Parks and Cemeteries.

CONDITIONS:

1. The Manager of Horticulture & Forestry Services reserves the right to:
 - a) Approve any preferred species of tree.
 - b) Approve the site for planting and suggest alternative sites.
 - c) Purchase the tree and deem the tree healthy upon its arrival.
2. Once planted, the tree becomes the sole responsibility of the Forestry Department, who will endeavour to keep the tree properly maintained.
3. Trees and plaques are warranted for a 10-year period.
4. Total costs are payable in person to the City of Cambridge Service Cambridge Counter, 1st floor at City Hall, 50 Dickson Street.
