



BY-LAW NO. 63- 17

of the

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a By-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to authorize the use of alternative voting methods for municipal elections.

WHEREAS Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act provides that the Council of a municipality may pass a by-law authorizing alternative voting methods and vote counting machines;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Cambridge deems it appropriate and in the public interest to utilize vote by internet, vote by telephone and paper ballot tabulation as the methods of conducting the 2018 municipal election;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

1. THAT alternative voting methods (internet, telephone and paper ballot tabulation) are hereby authorized pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act;
2. THAT electronic vote-counting equipment is hereby authorized pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act;
3. THAT the Municipal Clerk shall establish procedures and required forms for the alternative voting methods and electronic vote-counting equipment in accordance with Section 3 of the Municipal Elections Act;
4. THAT the Mayor and Clerk shall be authorized to execute the necessary agreements to provide for the alternative voting method and associated services;
5. THAT this By-law shall come into full force and effect on the date of its passage; and

6. THAT By-law 61-14 is hereby repealed.
7. THAT this by-law shall come into full force on the day it is passed.
