



BY-LAW 28-18

of the

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a By-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to submit to the electors a question pursuant to the Municipal Elections Act, 1996

WHEREAS subsection 8(1)(b) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, authorizes the Council to pass a by-law to submit a question not otherwise authorized by law but within the council's jurisdiction to the electors of the City of Cambridge;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge wishes to question the electors regarding changing the voting system to a Ranked Ballot Election for the 2022 Municipal Election;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

1. THAT the City Clerk/Returning Officer is hereby authorized and directed to place the following question on the ballot for the 2018 Municipal Election in the City of Cambridge pursuant to the requirements of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996:

"Are you in favour of the City of Cambridge using a ranked ballot system for the 2022 municipal election?"
