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

**Decision to give written approval of by-laws passed at the  
November 28, 2023, meeting of City Council**

Mayoral decision Under Bill 3, the Strong Mayors, Building Homes Act, 2022, which amended the Municipal Act, 2001, I, Jan Liggett, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, hereby give written approval of the following by-laws passed at the Cambridge City Council meeting of November 28, 2023, in accordance with subsection 284.11(4)(a)(i) of the Municipal Act, 2001:

- Council Agenda Item 7.3, by-law 23-099 to designate the property located at 12 Dayton Street as a property of cultural heritage value
- Council Agenda Item 7.3, by-law 23-100 to designate the property located at 74 Queen Street East as a property of cultural heritage value
- Council Agenda Item 7.3, by-law 23-101 to designate the property located at 119 Blair Road as a property of cultural heritage value
- Council Agenda Item 7.5, by-law 23-102 to authorize the construction of certain works in the City as a local improvement
- Council Agenda Item 8.3.3, by-law 23-103 to regulate or prohibit placing or dumping of fill, the removal of topsoil and the alteration of the grade of land, within the City of Cambridge and to repeal By-law 160-09
- Council Agenda Item 8.4.2, by-law 23-104 to establish maintenance standards for highways, bridges, roads, bike lanes, trails, and sidewalks
- Council Agenda Item 8.4.3, by-law 23-105 to regulate the destruction or injuring of trees on private property
- Council Agenda Item 17, by-law 23-106 to confirm the proceedings of the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge
