A commissioner is a person authorized by the Province of Ontario to take oaths or declarations when you sign an affidavit or statutory declaration. The City Clerk and Deputy City Clerk are, by virtue of office, commissioners for taking affidavits. This authority is conferred by the Commissioners for taking affidavit Act.
