
**Decision to give written approval of by-laws passed at the
October 24, 2023, meeting of City Council**

Mayoral decision Under Bill 3, the Strong Mayors, Building Homes Act, 2022, which amended the Municipal Act, 2001, I, Jan Liggett, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, hereby give written approval of the following by-laws passed at the Cambridge City Council meeting of October 24, 2023, in accordance with subsection 284.11(4)(a)(i) of the Municipal Act, 2001:

- Council Agenda Item 8.6, by-law 23-087 to exempt certain lots or blocks pursuant to subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, (Part Lot Control Exemption) – Block 96 on Registered Plan 58M-685
- Council Agenda Item 8.7, by-law 23-088 to exempt certain lots or blocks pursuant to subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended (Part Lot Control Exemption) – Block 98 on Registered Plan 58M-685
- Council Agenda Item 9.2.1, by-law 23-089 to amend By-law 23-050 to establish an Administrative Penalty System for violations of by-laws within the City of Cambridge and By-law 23-052 to designate various by-laws of the City of Cambridge as by-laws to which the Administrative Penalty System applies
