By-law 26-042

Being a by-law to authorize the use of alternative voting methods and vote count equipment for the 2026 Municipal and School Board Election.


WHEREAS Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996, S.O. c.32, as amended, provides that the council of a local municipality may pass a by-law authorizing the use of alternative voting methods that does not require electors to attend a voting place to vote;

AND WHEREAS Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996, S.O. c.32, as amended, provides that the council of a local municipality may pass a by-law authorizing the use of optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes at Municipal Elections.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the use of optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes in the 2026 City of Cambridge Municipal and School Board Election be hereby authorized.
2. **THAT** internet voting be hereby authorized as an alternative voting method in the 2026 City of Cambridge Municipal and School Board Election.
3. **THAT** By-law 21-092 is hereby repealed.
4. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and full effect on the date of passing.
