



BY-LAW 129-15

of the

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to amend the City of Cambridge Sign By-Law 191-03 being a by-law to prohibit or regulate signs and other advertising devices or any class or classes thereof on buildings or vacant lots within the City of Cambridge or on land abutting any defined highway or part of a highway.

WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights and powers of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority and that it may do so by by-law and, pursuant to subsection 11(3), paragraph 7, a local municipality may pass by-laws regulating the erection of signs;

AND WHEREAS Cambridge City Council deems it desirable to amend By-law 191-03;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

1. THAT Section 2 of the by-law be amended by adding:

Back Lit Box Sign or Internally Illuminated Sign means a sign with a translucent surface which is illuminated by light emitted from within the sign but does not include individually illuminated channel letters.

2. THAT Section 8 of the by-law be amended by adding regulation 7 as follows:

The following fascia signs are prohibited from being installed or erected on a building located within the core area boundaries as indicated on Schedules I, J and K:

- Back lit box sign or internally illuminated sign

3. THAT the City of Cambridge Sign By-law, Schedules I, J and K to By-law No. 129-15 be added, hereto attached.
4. THAT this by-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
