BY-LAW 62-17

of the

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a By-Law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to provide for regulating the sale, setting off and holding of fireworks displays and to amend By-law 159-15.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, S. 121 provides that a municipality may prohibit and regulate the sale of fireworks and the setting of fireworks;

AND WHEREAS a by-law pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O.2001, c.25, may prohibit the sale and setting off of fireworks unless a permit is obtained and conditions may be imposed for obtaining, continuing to hold and renewing the permit including requiring the submission of plans;

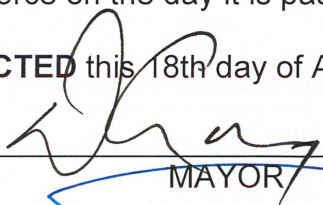
AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge deems it expedient to amend by-law 159-15 to regulate the setting off of fireworks within the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

1. THAT Section 5 be amended to read as follows:
 5. No person shall set off any fireworks on any day except Canada Day, Diwali and Victoria Day unless such person has first obtained a permit pursuant to paragraph 6 of this by-law except in the event that inclement weather prevents the setting off of fireworks on these days in which case any person may set off fireworks on any day within two days after Canada Day, Diwali or Victoria Day.

2. THAT By-Law 159-15 is hereby amended.
3. THAT this by-law shall come into full force on the day it is passed.
