



BY-LAW 19-016

of the

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a By-Law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to amend the Outdoor Business Licence By-Law 173-16 (housekeeping amendments).

**WHEREAS** By-Law 173-16 was passed to regulate and govern any outdoor local business operating in the City of Cambridge;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge deems it expedient to amend By-Law 173-16 for the purposes of general housekeeping updates;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

1. THAT Clause (a) in Section 7 (Validity of Licence) be amended to read as follows:  
“Every Licence shall be valid for the calendar year in which it is issued and shall expire on the 30<sup>th</sup> of April.”
2. THAT Clause (b) in Section 7 (Validity of Licence) be amended to read as follows:  
“Every Licence shall be subject to renewal annually upon payment (April 30<sup>th</sup>) of the appropriate renewal fee as noted in Schedule A and receipt of all information required by the Licensing Officer and this by-law. Every Licence shall be subject to an additional fee upon renewal payments, the second Friday in May as noted in Schedule A.”
3. THAT the License Fees and in Schedule A(1) to By-Law 142-16 be amended to read as follows:

Licence Fees
2019 - \$268.50
2020 - \$274.00

4. THAT the License Fees and in Schedule A(2) to By-Law 142-16 be amended to read as follows:

Licence Fees
2019 - \$10.00
2020 - \$10.00

5. THAT Clause 1(o) in Schedule A(3) be amended to read as follows:  
“A licence issued under this by-law shall be valid for a period of time expiring April 30<sup>th</sup> of the current year and shall be subject to renewal annually upon payment of the appropriate fee.

6. THAT the License Fees and in Schedule A(3) to By-Law 142-16 be amended to read as follows:

Licence Fees
2019 - \$106.00
2020 - \$108.00

7. THAT Clause 1(i) in Schedule A(4) be amended to read as follows:  
“A licence issued under this by-law shall be valid for a period of time not exceeding one year expiring April 30<sup>th</sup> of the current year and shall be subject to renewal annually upon payment of the appropriate fee.

8. THAT the License Fees and in Schedule A(4) to By-Law 142-16 be amended to read as follows:

Licence Fees
2019 - \$106.00
2020 - \$108.00

9. THAT Clause 1(f)(ii) in Schedule A(5) be amended to read as follows:  
“To any person except on Canada Day and on the day fixed by proclamation of the Governor General for the observations of Victoria Day and Diwali and during the preceding ten (10) days prior to the said days; and”.

10. THAT Clause 1(j) in Schedule A(5) is hereby deleted.  
“To any person except on Canada Day and on the day fixed by proclamation of the Governor General for the observation of Victoria Day and Diwali and during the preceding ten (10) days prior to the said days; and”.

11. THAT the License Fees and in Schedule A(5) to By-Law 142-16 be amended to read as follows:

Licence Fees
2019 - \$106.00
2020 - \$108.00

12. THAT Clause 1(i) in Schedule A(6) be amended to read as follows:

“A licence issued under this by-law shall be valid for a period of time expiring April 30<sup>th</sup> of the current year and shall be subject to renewal annually upon payment of the appropriate fee.

13. THAT the License Fees and in Schedule A(4) to By-Law 142-16 be amended to read as follows:

Licence Fees
2019 - \$106.00
2020 - \$108.00

14. THAT Section 10 (Renewal) in Schedule A(7) to By-Law 142-16 be added and worded as follows:

“All Year Permits are subject to renewal and shall expire April 30<sup>th</sup> of the current year.”

15. THAT the License Fees and in Schedule A(8) to By-Law 142-16 be amended to read as follows:

16. THAT the License Fees and in Schedule A(9) to By-Law 142-16 be amended to read as follows:



17. THAT Section 11(d) in Schedule A (9) to By-law 173-16 be amended to read as follows:  
“All persons engaging in the operation of a motorized refreshment vehicle provide to the Licensing Officer upon application their valid Class G or equivalent government issued licence and vulnerable sector check issued by their local police service.”
  
18. THAT Section 11(e) in Schedule A (9) to By-law 173-16 be amended to read as follows:  
“All persons engaging in sales in a motorized refreshment vehicle provide to the Licensing Officer a sales application as provided by the Licensing Officer and a vulnerable sector check issued by their local police service.”
  
19. THAT this By-Law shall come into full force on the day it is passed.
